

Thank you for volunteering to raise funds to support Steven Walter Children's Cancer Foundation. We are eternally grateful to the people, groups and organisations who donate and support our mission to find a cure for childhood cancer.

Since 2000, Steven Walter Children's Cancer Foundation has proudly been raising funds for much needed and vital cancer research. Over the last 50 years the cure rates for children living with cancer have improved from 10 per cent to 80 per cent, much of which is due to research into new treatments and therapies. Unfortunately though, this cutting edge exploratory research is rarely well supported. And even with the progress that's been made, for every 10 children diagnosed with cancer, three do not survive. Here in Australia, that translates to three children losing their lives to cancer every week.

We believe that is three children too many.

So SWCCF is committed to fundraising to support research with the ultimate target of 100% survival of all children diagnosed with cancer and the prevention of their suffering. Every child with cancer can be guaranteed a future and an improved quality of life. With your support we can work towards new discoveries that will save children's lives.

ABOUT STEVEN WALTER CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION



STEVEN WALTER CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION'S TARGET IS 100 PER CENT SURVIVAL FOR ALL CHILDREN DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER AND THE PREVENTION OF THEIR SUFFERING.

Whilst big steps forward have been made since we started working towards this, there is still a way to go before we reach our goal. Why did we set such an ambitious target? Because of a young man called Steven Walter. Steve was only nineteen years old when he died in the year 2000 after a heroic eight-year fight against cancer. He was diagnosed with cancer in his right leg at 11 years of age and fought bravely through chemotherapy and the removal of a major bone in his leg. Unfortunately the cancer returned when Steve was 16 and although his cancer could not be cured, his hope was that one day all children would survive. It is because of this extraordinary young man's determination and his passion for life that his family, friends and others have gone on to create the Steven Walter Children's Cancer Foundation.

SWCCF is determined to fulfil Steve's final wish to raise money for research into childhood cancer ***"so that one day no other kid will have to go through what I've been through"***.

SEVEN STEPS TO FUNDRAISE FOR SWCCF

1 CHOOSE YOUR EVENT

There are many ways to fundraise but the best advice we can give is to choose an event or activity that you will enjoy. Think of ideas that will work in your local community and appeal to your family, friends and colleagues. Set realistic goals and timeframes for the activity or event and choose a time that suits you. We've brainstormed some examples of what you can do and they're listed on page 6.

2 REGISTER WITH SWCCF

If you've decided to host a fundraiser on SWCCF's behalf please register your event or activity. This will help us provide you with support and advice on other requirements. Depending on the type and size of the activity you're planning, you may also need to check with your local council or authority to gain the proper permissions.

When you've chosen an activity or event, complete and sign the 'Meet the Challenge' fundraising registration form and return it to SWCCF.

3 AUTHORITY TO FUNDRAISE ON BEHALF OF SWCCF

SWCCF will review your application to ensure it fits within appropriate legal and safety requirements and provide you with an Authority to fundraise letter. Once you've received this letter you can start organising your fundraising activity.

4 PROMOTING YOUR EVENT/ACTIVITY

Send your event details to admin@stevenwalterfoundation.org.au and we'll include it on the events calendar on the SWCCF website. Please provide as much information as possible to help us help you!

SWCCF is registered with Everyday Hero, so you can create your very own unique fundraising page at www.everydayhero.com.au and nominate to support SWCCF.

It's an easy way to track how much you've raised.

5 START FUNDRAISING

The first steps can be daunting, so we suggest you look around you to start thinking about recruiting helpers and promoting your activity. You'll be surprised how many of your contacts can support you and/or donate! Most of all, make sure it's fun and enjoyable for you and your helpers.

6 DEPOSIT THE FUNDS YOU'VE RAISED

Once you have held your event please transfer the funds to SWCCF as soon as possible following the completion of your fundraising activity.

Send an email or letter to let people know how you went and how much you raised for SWCCF.
